Las Vegas, NV, August 19, 2006 – A new exhibit appearing at the Liberace Museum in Las Vegas features the fabulous footwear of the show-off of show business, the godfather of glam, the man himself-Liberace.

On display are Liberace's American flag inspired oxfords designed for his famous 1970's hot-pants costume; a rare look at an archetypical Liberace-style sneaker; a blue knee-high boot with beads, rhinestones and edged with mink fur and enough bling to sanction Liberace his due as the *King of Bling*.
